## "Open access to JRC research infrastructures"

The Joint Research Center of the European Commission (JRC) has opened access to its infrastructures by announcing calls for research on the basis of:

*European research infrastructure for nuclear reaction, radioactivity, radiation and technology studies in science and applications (EUFRAF)* (Geel, Belgium)

This infrastructure includes four laboratories that will provide measurement of nuclear reactions and decay data. Such measurements will help to make nuclear reactors and nuclear waste management safe, as well as enhance the radiological protection of citizens and the environment.
